Portfolio Update

In July, portfolio holdings in Japan contributed the most to performance while holdings in Europe, the emerging markets and the Middle East detracted the most. Holdings in the consumer staples and industrials sectors contributed the most to relative performance, while holdings in the health care and energy sectors detracted the most. While public and investor focus on Greece appears to have faded, attention has turned to the secondary, longer-lasting effects on economic and policy issues globally. Economies that depend on exports may have to restructure and find alternative avenues of growth principally by making their policies and regulations more beneficial to the private sector. As a result, we could easily see more growth opportunities in the developed markets in addition to emerging markets.

Net income and net realized capital gains may be paid annually.

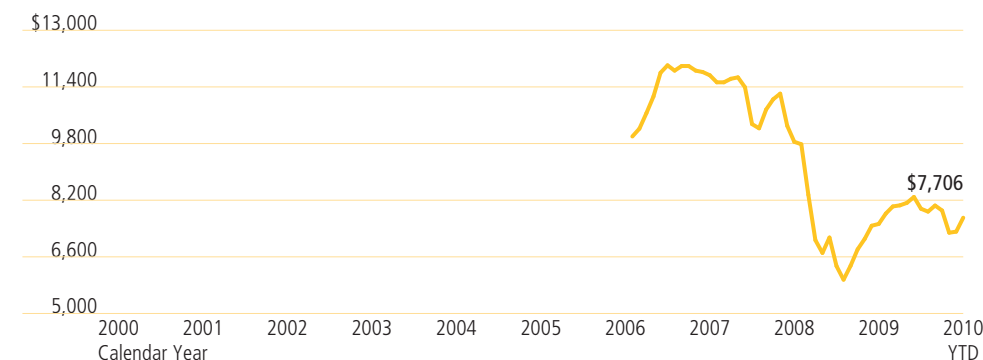
